- Nomination deadline (Online Application)

- Application deadline (Online Application)

- Application documents
- 1st: A copy of passport, Study Plan(Attachment), Recommendation Letter, Official transcript
- 2nd: Health clearance, Flight info, Copy of Korea visa, Course wish list

Language requirement

SeoulTech requires a good knowledge of English(CEFR B2 level) or Korean(TOPIK3 level) in order to communicate and function in an academic context.



Insurance

All international students residing in Korea must register to National Health Insurance after March 1, 2021 in accordance with Korean law.
